### Accountability Ratings

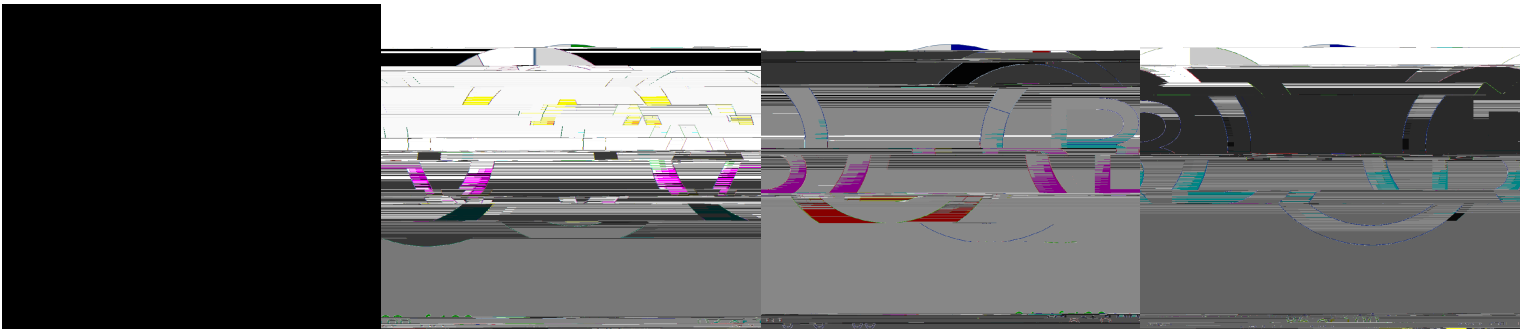

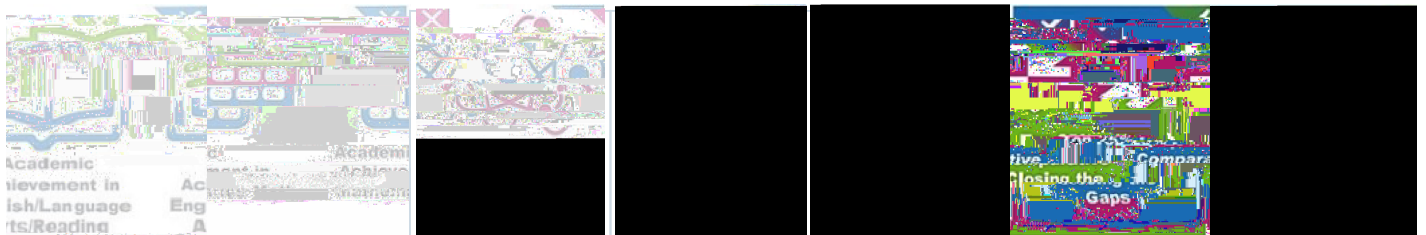
