### Accountability Ratings

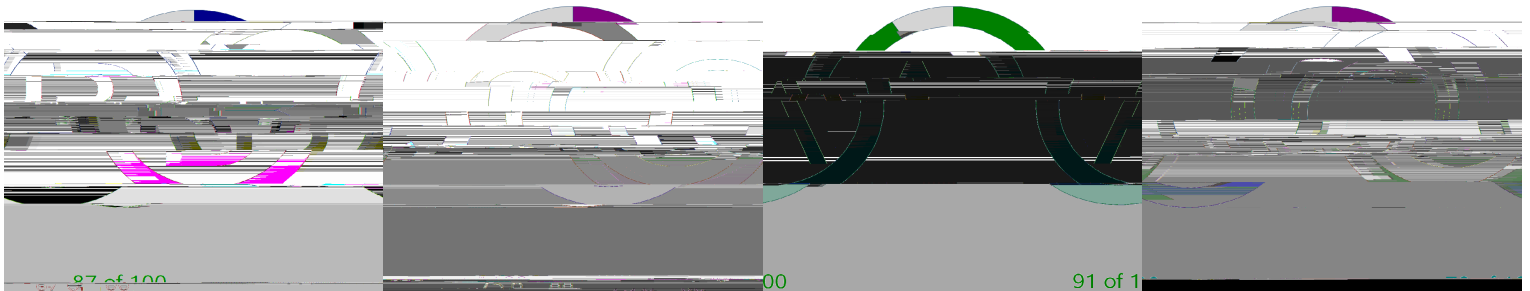
