



Testing procedures for home schooled students

According to TEC 29.916, school districts are required to allow home school students the opportunity to participate in PSAT/NQMST and Advanced Placement (AP) testing.

Home schooled students are to follow the procedures below in order to sign up for AP and PSAT/NQMST with McKinney Independent School District:

- Acquire Home School Code from the College Board or other appropriate source for home schooled student. College Board main website: <http://www.collegeboard.com/>
- Contact the High School Lead Counselor and/or Associate Principal of the High School the home schooled student is zoned to attend. You can find this information at:

- Provide name, address and home school code to the high school.
- Make arrangements with Lead counselor for testing (date, location, time) with high school.
- Provide payment for test(s) to be taken.
- AP exams: Make check payable to McKinney ISD. Regular registration ends the last day of school before the Fall-break for all-year AP courses, and by the last day of school before Spring break for one-semester courses. Registration after these dates will result in a late-fee.
- PSAT /NMQST test: Make check payable to the appropriate McKinney ISD campus. This is the high school campus that will administer the PSAT test to the student. Regular registration ends three weeks before test date for PSAT/NQMST.
