The major criterion for exclusion from attendance is the probability of spread from person to person. A child could have a noncommunicable illness yet require care at home or in a hospital. (

Condition

-Spread by oral route through saliva, e.g. kissing, mouthing toys, etc.

Commonly 30-50 days

-Variable  
-Infants and young children are generally asymptomatic  
-Symptoms, when present, include fever, fatigue, swollen lymph nodes, and sore throat

Yes

Exclude until physician decides or  
exclude until fever free<sup>6</sup>
