If you suspect an infant, child or young adult of having a developmental delay or disability, your school can open a window of hope for a brighter future.

Each child is unique and all have the right to an education, but some have special needs or concerns when it comes to learning. Services at no cost to the family are available to all eligible individuals from 3 through 21 years of age (starting at birth for auditory and visual impairments) regardless of the severity of their disability.

Learning experiences encourage intellectual, social and emotional growth. Children develop selfcon dence and the ability to get along with others. Every child has the capacity to learn, to develop and to grow to his or her full potential.
